Digital colposcopes lack the advanced EMR integration that Seiler offers and require additional steps to bring images into EMR systems.

The VarioFocus accessory - which is unique to Seiler - allows the end user to maintain focus over a wide working distance range of 198mm to 455mm without moving the colposcope back and forth.



Working Distance



Typically users must move the unit to refocus and can only stay in focus between 250 - 300 mm during a procedure reducing efficiency.
